Lawrence served in WW I as a Lieutenant in the US Army. After the war, Lawrence was an Instructor at the Hanson Auto & Tractor School in Fargo. In January 1920, Lawrence was a boarder in the home of Arthur and Stella Branson, in Fargo. In April 1930, Lawrence was working as a hardware merchant, his sister Nora (school teacher) was living with he and Ida.

In 1942 Lawrence and Ida moved to Seattle. Lawrence was a member of American Legion, Queen Anne Post. Lawrence was in the Real Estate business on Queen Anne Hill. In 1952 he was employed by the University of Washington, where he retired in 1962.
